TODAY'S SCRIPTURE
"Baptism of Christ"

John was preaching and baptizing at the Jordan River. He was really preparing the people to accept Jesus as Messiah. Then Jesus arrives on the scene and asks to be baptized. Naturally, John was surprised and tried to remonstrate with Him. Jesus responded that it is fitting "to fulfill all righteousness." Perhaps He was saying that it was appropriate for Him to do this in order to set an example for the rest of the people. Whatever His intent was, we know that John baptized Him.

There are several things we should remember about this event. Firstly, what John was doing was not a Sacramental Baptism as we know it. There were no Sacraments until Christ's death and resurrection. This was a ritual to help the people become repentant of their sins and be ready to accept Christ and His teaching. Secondly, Jesus had no sin so He did not need any Rite of Purification. Lastly, John did as Christ asked.

The Baptism of Jesus is presented to us by the church at the beginning of our new year. The church wants us to focus on our own Baptism and how we are responding to the grace of Baptism and living our baptismal commitments. At Jesus' Baptism, John saw the Spirit of God descend on Jesus and heard a voice from heaven declare, "This is my beloved Son in whom I am well pleased."

When we were baptized, we received the Holy Spirit—the life of God. God came to us so that we might live in a close relationship with Him and live a life pleasing to Him. We should ask ourselves what is our relationship with God and how may we improve that relationship. Hopefully we are at peace with God. If not, then there is probably some matter of conscience that keeps us from a happy relationship with Him. So, the way to a better relationship is by repentance and seeking reconciliation with God and others. If we are blessed to be at peace with God, we should strive to improve that relationship. Our best means of developing a deeper relationship with God is through prayer. Do we spend as much time in prayer as we might? What guides our prayer? First of all, our prayer should be praise of God for His goodness. Then we should seek His mercy expressing sorrow for our sins or shortcomings of our life. Having made our peace with God, we can then seek His help in our needs.

To further nurture our relationship with God, we should focus on doing as Christ has taught regarding our relationship with others. Finally, our Baptism calls us to continue the work of Christ today. Are we being good witnesses for Him?

This Sunday at the 10:15 mass we celebrate the *Rite of Reception of Baptized Christians into the Full Communion of the Catholic Church* with Renee Perusich and Hunter Limb. Today they complete their Sacrament of Initiation with Confirmation and Eucharist.

The Sacraments of Christian Initiation (C 1212, USC p. 183). The *Catechism* (1285) states that *Baptism, the Eucharist and Confirmation together constitute the "sacraments of Christian initiation,"* whose unity must be safe-guarded. The three sacraments of initiation are closely related.



- Baptism brings the new life of Christ;
- Confirmation strengthens the new life of Christ;
- and the Eucharist nourishes the new life of Christ.

Together they make us full members of the Church and they bestow the fullness of the Holy Spirit so that we can live more like Christ.

The Act of Reception (RCIA p. 492). The Lord receives you into the Catholic Church. His loving kindness has led you here, so that in the unity of the Holy Spirit you may have full communion with us in the faith that you have professed in the presence of His family.
