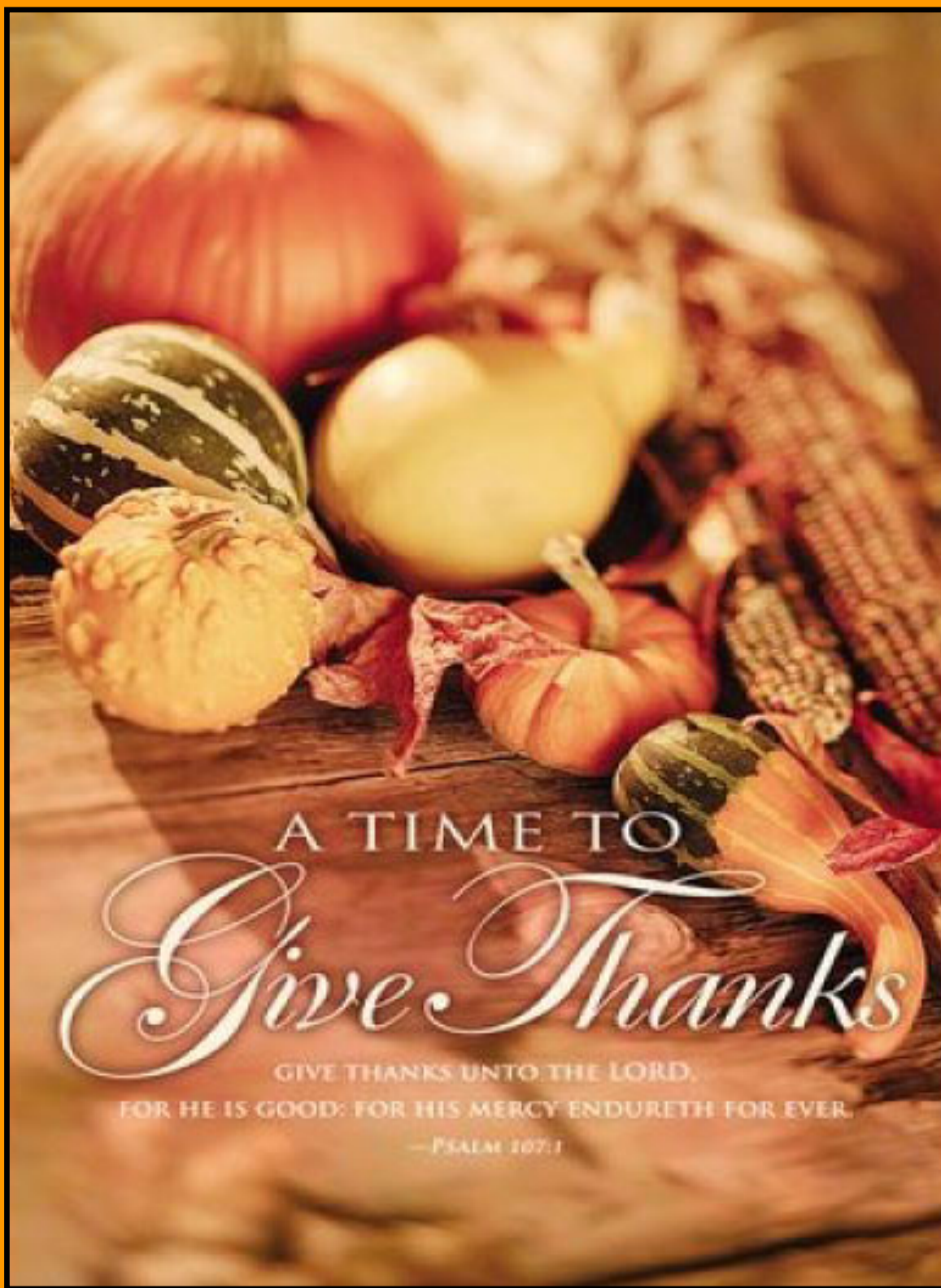

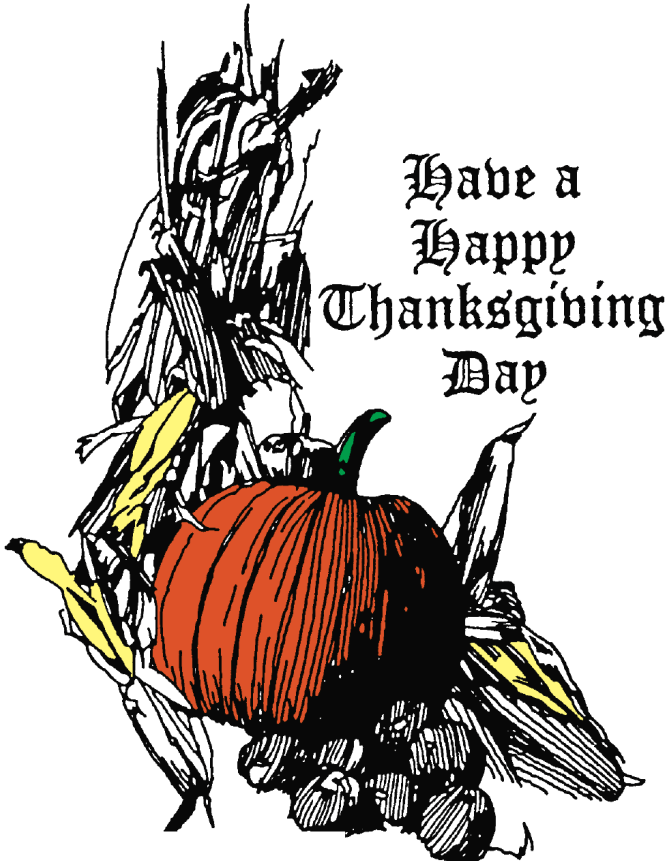

**TODAY'S GOSPEL MESSAGE**  
**"SHARE THE BLESSINGS"**

"Amen, I say to you, whatever you did for one of the least of my brothers, you did for Me."  
Matt 25:40

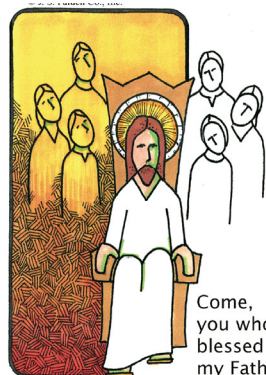
The Gospel for this, the last Sunday of the Church's year, presents us with the picture of the Judgment. The good will be assembled on His right; the wicked on His left. He will invite the good to "enter into the Kingdom". The wicked He will consign to "Everlasting Fire".

On what will we be judged? Our eternity will be determined by the charity we have shown others. He tells us that what we do for others—the hungry, the thirsty, the naked, the stranger, the ill, the imprisoned—we do for Him. So the Judgment will not be in terms of keeping the Commandments, which is very important, but in the ways we show love and care for others. How do we use the blessings God has given us? Do we share our blessings with the poor, the needy, the less blessed? It is a serious question for us anytime, but it is especially appropriate this week as we celebrate Thanksgiving. We have been so abundantly blessed that we have a real need to show our gratitude to God.

The best way to show our thanks is to share our blessings with others. Our sharing may not be a matter of money; giving financial help to the needy, etc. It should also include genuine concern for those suffering by spending time with those who are ill or infirmed by visiting those who have lost their freedom and are in prison. Those are the instances that Christ mentions for us, but there are probably many more. We encounter them every day and when we do, we must be willing to help whoever the needy or afflicted may be. Our Judgment depends on it.

Let us support the Thanksgiving Food Drive, which provides the basics for those who come to Our Saviour's in total need. The need has never been greater as the number of families seeking our help for the past several months has tripled over the past year. By our charity, we are giving dignity and hope to many affected by our economy. We are following the example set by Christ who fed the multitudes in the desert. Then, one day we can expect to hear Him say to us, "Well done good and Faithful Servant, enter into the Joy of the Lord."

## FROM THE DEACON'S DEN

Next Sunday is the beginning of Advent and the use of the new Roman Missal (the beginning of a new cycle, B). Remember there are 3 cycles for Sundays and 2 cycles for weekdays. So in a 3 yr. period we may hear almost the entire Bible. The Church (Christ) provides us with these liturgical seasons to give us additional grace. Use it to help your family (Yes, even grandparents!) get more out of Christmas and not just think of Christmas as a time to get presents. *When the Church celebrates the liturgy of Advent each year, she makes present this ancient expectancy of the Messiah, for by sharing in the long preparation for the Savior's first coming, the faithful renew their ardent desire for his second coming.* (CC 524) Here are some Advent traditions and Internet links you might find helpful: 1) **Advent wreath:** It symbolizes the many years in which the world awaited its Redeemer. It holds 4 equally spaced candles, 3 purple ones lit on the "penitential" Sundays and a pink one for Gaudete, joyful 3rd Sunday, 2) **The empty manger:** When acts of service, sacrifice, or kindness are done in honor of Baby Jesus, a child receives a piece of straw to put into the manger. On Christmas morning, "Baby Jesus" is placed in the manger, 3) **The Jesse tree:** The Jesse tree tells about Christ's ancestry through symbols and relates Scripture to salvation history, progressing from creation to the birth of Christ, 4) **St. Nicholas Day** is on Dec. 6th. Many families give gifts on both Dec. 6 and Christmas, 5) **The Christ candle:** A large white candle is decorated with symbols for Christ and lit on Christmas Eve to show the Light of the World is here, 6) **St. Lucy cakes:** The feast of St. Lucy, virgin and martyr, is on Dec. 13<sup>th</sup> so, bake this traditional cake on her day, 7) Set up or create a **Nativity scene:** 8) **Bake Christmas goodies** as a family, 9) **Pick out (or even cut down) your Christmas tree** as a family and then bless it.
