**TODAY'S GOSPEL MESSAGE**

“Watch, therefore; you do not know when the Lord of the house is coming.”  
Mark 13:35

We start off a new liturgical year today with those words. As we turn over another page of the calendar or hang a new calendar, Christ is admonishing us to be alert and stay awake because we do not know “*when the Lord of the house is coming.*”

As we look back at the liturgical year just past, hopefully we feel good about how we have used God’s graces and the time He has given us. Perhaps we may have some regrets about opportunities not taken or possibilities not pursued. This, then, is a good time to review and make some serious commitments about the future. We live in times that are difficult, as the economy slows and people are out of work or on short hours. No doubt, everyone will “be alert” for any possible opportunity to find work. We will set the alarm and hit the floor as soon as it goes off. We will race for an appointment for an interview to get one of the few jobs available, knowing that “*the early bird catches the worm.*” In all of this hustle to get ahead in the workplace, we are reminded of Christ’s statement, “*The children of this world are more enterprising than the children of light.*” Yes, we miss no opportunity to get ahead at the business of business. What about the only business that is truly important—matters of the spirit and eternity?

That is what Jesus is talking about in the Gospel today, when He tells us “*be alert.*” Are we attentive to God’s word which we hear in church or which we read in our Bible? Does His word change any of our decisions or our attitudes? Do we allow His word to affect how we conduct our business or how we treat our neighbor? No doubt we want to be holy, but what place do we give God in our life or how much time do we dedicate to prayer, worship or meditation which makes God real to us? Be Alert! How important are the Commandments in our scheme of things? Are they dictates to be observed always or merely suggestions to be avoided when they seem inconvenient? Where does charity, kindness, acceptance, tolerance and forgiveness fit into our lifestyle? Be Alert!

Yes, be alert for the things of the Spirit. At our funeral no one will say how much money we made, what kind of house we lived in or what position of power we held. But, they will say “he was always kindly, considerate, sensitive to others, helpful, and a person of Great Faith.” Be Alert! Another year has gone by.

Today is the First Sunday of Advent, which begins the special Season of Preparation for celebrating the Birth of Our Saviour, Jesus Christ. It is a season to concentrate on Christ being reborn in our lives. It is a season to be attentive to God’s word and to respond generously to the grace God gives us to live in His presence. We may have a busy schedule striving to take care of all the details of preparing for Christmas. Those preparations for family gatherings, etc. are important, but we miss the point if we omit the spiritual from our schedules.

There are many people in our world who feel lost and who are searching for answers to their questions. We can fulfill their quest for the spiritual. We are offering a special program during this Advent to reach out to those who have wandered from Christ or the Church.

Please invite your friends, especially those who may be alienated from the church, to attend church with you during Advent and pray that Christ may change the heart of the wanderer.

## FROM THE DEACON'S DEN

Have you ever heard someone (Probably one of your children!) say, "I don't get anything out of Mass," or you may have even thought something like this yourself after Mass. Obviously on any given day we may have had distractions or problems that made it difficult to concentrate during Mass. When this happens to me during Mass, I ask the Lord to forgive me right away, which then helps me to concentrate better on the Mass. However, when someone makes such a statement we should wonder about their faith and pray for them to grow in their faith, because they have at least received Jesus in the Eucharist, even if they did not receive Him in the Word. My wife, Ellen, and I were listening to a CD in the car which you might want to get. It was titled, "*Becoming The-Best-Version-of-Yourself*" by Matthew Kelly. Ellen picked it up from the display in the narthex from Lighthouse Catholic Media (of course after giving a donation). Part of his talk includes a worthwhile presentation on the season of Advent. One of the best points he makes is a simple suggestion on how to get more out of Mass. During Sunday Mass make a sincere effort to find at least one action that you can implement in your life. If you go to daily Mass, then work to come away with at least one new understanding of our Faith. Just think how much you would grow in your faith in a year's time. Finally, to help you get more out of Mass come to church early and spend a few minutes praying and asking to Holy Spirit to help you to hear and receive Jesus! 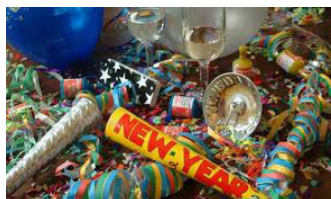
