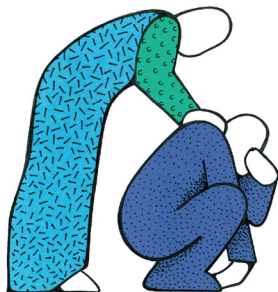
The struggle to survive and make ends meet is sometimes difficult and perhaps even worrisome at times. Job security, slow economy and lack of enough money to provide for the family as we would like can be very stressful. But have you ever noticed that God,

through His written word, so very often speaks to us about the varied situations in which we may find ourselves? So it is in today's Gospel. Christ tells us not to worry about all those things that we consider so important. Rather, He reminds us, that God knows all that we need—and provides for all our needs. It raises the question of trust and how much we trust God. Yes, of course we trust God, but it is easier to believe when we have material proof. However there is so much about our relationship with God that cannot have material proof. Yet God is there and he is always true to His promises.

We see this in the Old Testament where God enters into covenant with His people and repeatedly provides for them or rescues them from difficult situations. Christ came as the fulfillment of God's promise of a Savior. As he went about He touched many lives, encouraging, forgiving, healing and He promised "I am with you until the end of the world." So very often in life we strive to solve all our problems with common sense or the wisdom of the world. We leave God out of the equation and very often end up more frustrated and confused. We forget that Christ assured us, "I will be with you until the end of the world."

May we always keep in mind that we are in God's hands at all times. While we are in the hand of God, His plan for us is moving to its fulfillment. Perhaps some times we do not see the hand of God in our life, but it is there just as surely as the sun will rise tomorrow. Let us strive to deepen our trust in God's provident love for us. When we trust in God, life's little difficulties are much easier to handle and all of life will be much more fulfilling and meaningful.

OUR SAVIOUR SCHOOL NEWS



Our Saviour Catholic School has begun enrollment for the 2011-2012 School Year. Tuition is posted on the school web site, www.oursaviourschool.org, look under 'Prospective Families'. We enthusiastically invite you and your family to consider the outstanding values-based education offered by our U.S. Department of Education National Blue Ribbon School of Excellence. Considering that only 50 private schools in the entire nation are selected each year, it is clear that Our Saviour is quite an excellent school! In addition, our students consistently place in the top 10% of the nation on the Iowa Test of Basic Skills and the Assessment of Catholic Religious Education! Are you considering enrolling your child in Our Saviour Catholic School, but think you cannot afford it? We want to be sure that you know about several scholarship programs and our parish tuition assistance programs! The first thing you need to know is that our Pastor has said, "Do not let money be a reason for not enrolling your child in Catholic school!" He and our parish community are firmly committed to making a Catholic education available to *all* who desire to have one! Here are some opportunities that may be available to your family:

Step Up for Children Scholarship

In the 2009-2010 school year, \$106 million in scholarships were awarded to 28,927 students to attend private schools in the State of Florida, under the income-based, Florida Tax Credit Scholarship Program. In 2010-2011, the scholarships awarded were \$4,106 per student, toward the school tuition of \$4,600 for an "in parish" student! The difference of \$494.00, which amounts to about \$14.00 per week, makes a quality Catholic education very affordable for qualifying families! McKay Scholarship

The John M. McKay Scholarship Program is a school choice program that allows students with learning differences or disabilities, who have received Individualized Educational Plans (IEP's) through the public school system, to attend private schools, which might better serve their needs. 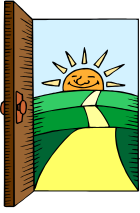
FROM THE DEACON'S DEN
